#### Area D - New Road

18-22 (formerly the Chiropodist, now located at West End Terrace), services will be disconnected mid August and followed by demolition. A full archaeological recording study will take place during the demolition to record details for posterity.

#### Area G - Cragg Brook

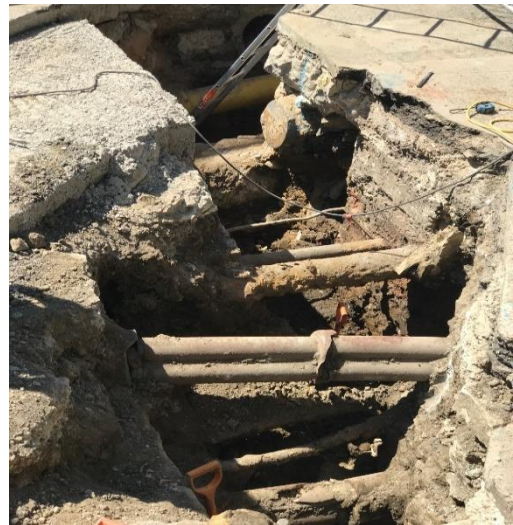
The issue with the unchartered service has been resolved and foundations for the new footbridge have now been completed.
