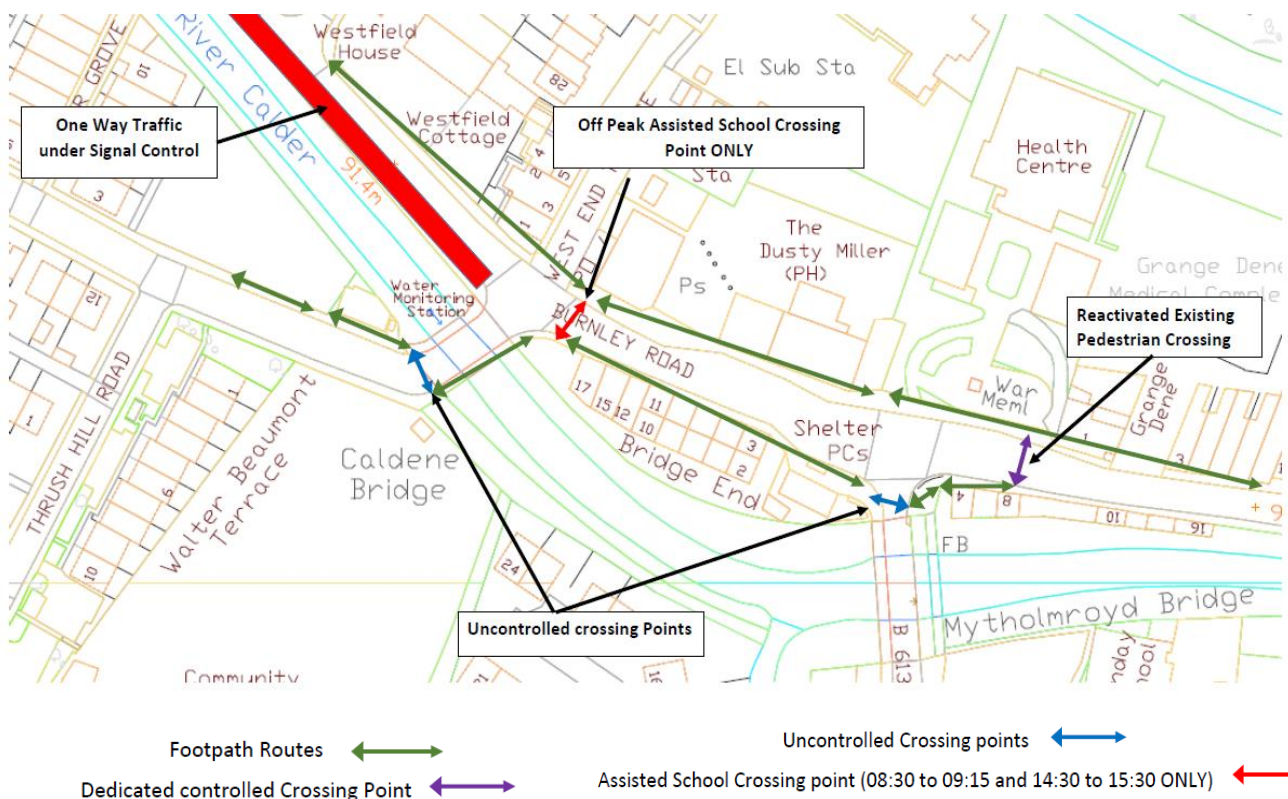

## Keeping you informed Pedestrian Crossings

August, 2018

In order to facilitate the next element of the flood alleviation scheme, you will be aware of the changes to the traffic management configuration. One pedestrian crossing is currently in place to cross Burnley Road, located at the junction by Grange Dean/New Road, opposite the war memorial. This will remain the main operational crossing for the village.

However, as the school term commences next week, we have arranged for an additional assisted crossing to be reinstated at the Caldene Avenue junction to enable a safe place to cross from 8.30am – 9.15am and from 2.30pm to 3.30pm Mon-Fri only. **This crossing will not be operational outside these times.**



Please take extra care, look out for our signage and always use the current operational crossing.
