WALL FINISHES CONSULTATION

A sample panel is currently being constructed in the Community Centre Car Park to indicate the choice of wall finishes for the area between Caldene Bridge and Whitehouses. Unique voting tokens are being delivered to the 3000 residents and businesses in Mytholmroyd with details of the consultation. There will also be drop in sessions at the Community Centre on the 27th, 29th and 30th of November and voting boxes will be available in the Post Office and Community Centre for your votes until the 3rd December.

Construction Update



Cragg Brook – Left Bank

Construction of new masonry wall adjacent to the bridge has begun.

Cragg Brook – Right Bank

A new design has been agreed and installation of lego blocks to form the new foundation is well under way. This will be completed by 24th November ready for the new flood walls.

10 Calder Grove

Work has begun inside the building to construct new underpinned foundations to allow building of the new gable wall when demolition is complete.
