What do they mean? Make sure you share this with your family



FLOOD ALERT



- Prepare a bag that includes medicines and insurance documents
- Visit flood-warning-information.service.gov.uk



FLOOD WARNING



- Turn off gas, water and electricity
- Move things upstairs or to safety
- Move family, pets and car to safety



SEVERE FLOOD WARNING



- Call 999 if in immediate danger
- Follow advice from emergency services
- Keep yourself and your family safe
