Piling rig removal this week – Caldene Bridge area

As part of our construction activities for the Mytholmroyd Flood Alleviation Scheme (FAS), our site operatives will be working extended hours (until approximately 7pm) in the Caldene Bridge area (Area E) for the remainder of this week (from 8th January) and into the weekend.

These extended working hours are required to complete piling work in the area prior to the removal of the large auger piling rig currently on site. The rig has been arranged for removal by a pre-arranged police escort on Saturday morning and we must meet this deadline in order to continue work without delay. Work will then continue in this area over the weekend to prepare the area for the next phase of the work.

There will be occasions throughout the project where changes in our work pattern such as this are required to facilitate specific construction activities. We do not envisage this temporary change to our working pattern causing any additional disruption to the community and will endeavour to keep any increased noise to a minimum.
