Traffic Management

Thank you for your patience last week whilst three way lights were in place at the junction of Caldene Avenue and Burnley Road. This work was completed ahead of schedule and we were able to remove the additional three way lights quicker than expected. Two way lights are now back in place as Yorkshire Water continue with their service diversion works on the junction of Caldene Avenue and Burnley Road, moving into Caldene Avenue by the Community Centre entrance.

From the 26th October, our traffic management will be extended along Burnley Road for approximately 10 days to facilitate work being carried out by the Co-op. This will mean a longer stretch of single carriageway and we do expect an increase in the time it takes to travel through the village during this period. We apologise for any additional inconvenience during these temporary adjustments.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Area E – Caldene Bridge

You will have noticed the large piling rig and crane now in the village. This is to enable us to commence concrete bored piling work to the central pier of the new Caldene bridge and will shortly be moving onto the Burnley Road abutment.

Area C – St Michael's Church

Works to under pin the stone buttress in front of the church continue in preparation for the installation of the new mini piled foundation later in the month. Protection has been installed that will preserve the historic stained glass windows whilst these works are underway.

Works in front of the new piled wall have commenced to install the new stone sets in the river channel. The concrete bed will be placed and sets added as the water levels allow.
