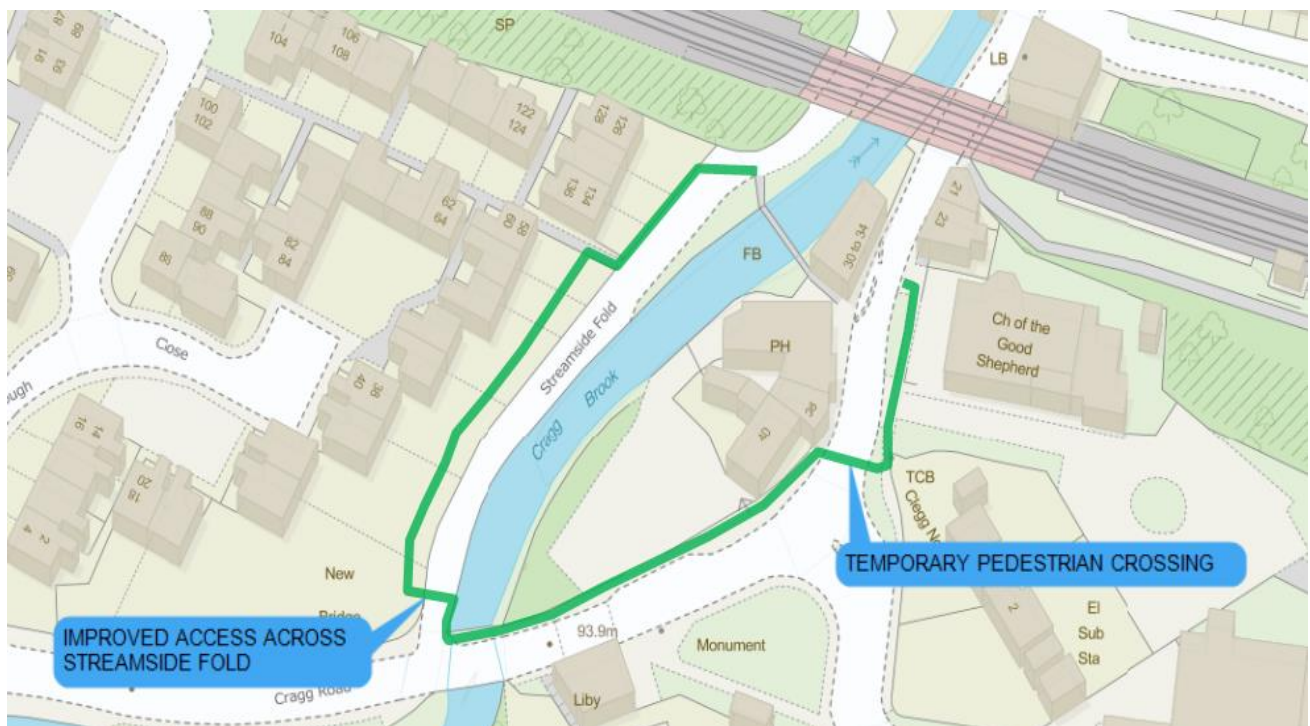

Keeping you informed Cragg Brook Footbridge

As part of the work to build flood defence walls for the Mytholmroyd Flood Alleviation Scheme, we will temporarily need to remove the footbridge across Cragg Brook (by the Shoulder of Mutton Public House). This will take place around 9th May and the bridge will be replaced in August.

We appreciate the inconvenience this may cause for regular users of the footbridge and have introduced some measures to assist residents in finding an alternative route to cross the river. A temporary pelican crossing will be in place on Cragg Road to enable pedestrians to cross before the narrow and uneven pavement and we will be improving the access on Streamside Fold to make it safer to cross the road at that point.

The map below shows the alternative route, the location of improvements and position of the temporary crossing:
