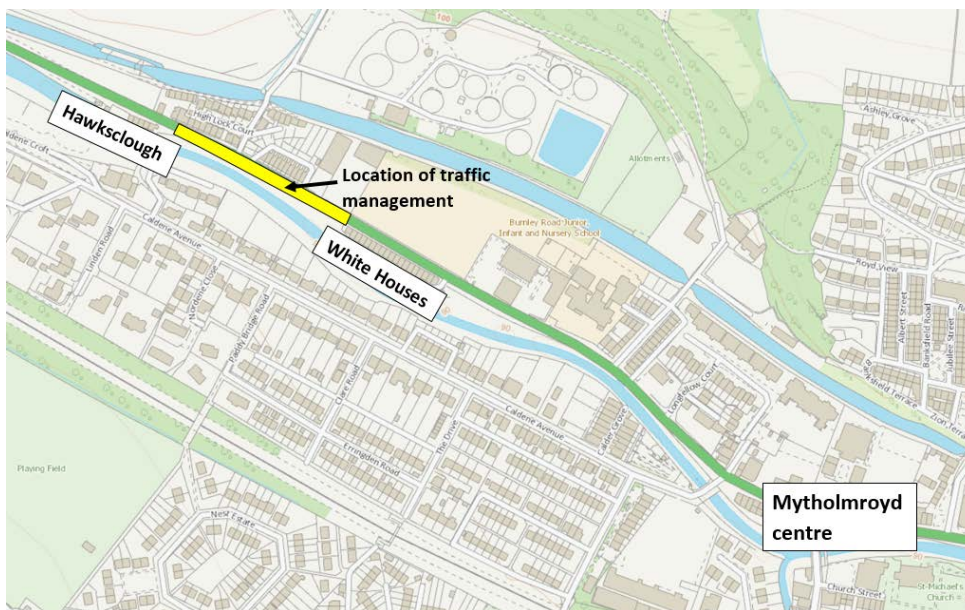

Traffic management on Burnley Road

During the week commencing Monday 18 January we will be carrying out work in the river channel between White Houses and Hawksclough. The river bank in that location will be reinforced to provide additional protection against scour in high river flows.

This work will require the closure of one lane of traffic on Burnley Road during working hours to enable safe access to the channel. The work is expected to take up to 5 days to complete. One lane of traffic will be closed along the length of the working area, with traffic lights in place from approximately 8am – 4pm each day.

The location of the traffic management is indicated on the plan below.
